Process for the day


- Introductions to generate personal responses Be prepared to engage

- Recording and reporting via notes & social media
 - After Council+ delegates and others can monitor feedback based on draft notes from the National Office
 - Use these, and your personal notes from the day to report to others as well as follow on issues personally
- Branches can send their Branch Trustee and one additional branch nominee. Branches with no Trustee or where Trustees are not able to attend might also send an alternative to enable the branch to get full representation.
- Includes distance access to the meeting if required. Anyone unable to be there in person can attend as 'virtual delegates', viewing online
